A meaningful contribution does not always have to be financial.

A school bag lying unused in a cupboard, a storybook gathering dust on a shelf, or a toy your child has outgrown could become a cherished possession for a child who has never had one.

For many children in the communities we serve, even the most basic necessities remain out of reach. Some children attend school wearing faded, oversized, or torn clothes because their families cannot afford new ones. They continue to wear the same clothes through changing seasons, often without a warm sweater, a proper pair of shoes, or even clean clothes for school.

While clothes are an everyday necessity for many of us, for these children, receiving a clean dress, a school uniform, or a warm jacket can restore confidence, dignity, and a sense of belonging.

Many children also grow up without ever owning a toy. They watch other children play, wander through streets and neighbourhoods searching for discarded toys, or create games from whatever objects they can find. Their childhood slowly passes without a doll to care for, a ball to play with, a puzzle to solve, or a storybook to call their own.

“Kabhi-kabhi poora bachpan beet jaata hai, lekin ek apna khilona bhi naseeb nahi hota.”

Childhood should be filled with play, imagination, laughter, curiosity, and dreams — not with the constant struggle to find basic necessities. A simple toy may appear small to us, but for a child, it can become a companion, a source of happiness, and a beautiful childhood memory.

At **Pehal Sanstha**, we invite individuals, families, schools, colleges, housing societies, shops, institutions, and corporate organisations to give their unused belongings a meaningful second life by donating new or gently used items to children from underserved communities.

Every item we receive is carefully collected, sorted, cleaned wherever required, and distributed respectfully so that it reaches children and families who genuinely need it.

Clothing and Daily Essentials

- Clean and gently used clothes for children and adolescents
- School uniforms in wearable condition
- Sweaters, jackets, woollen clothes, caps, and blankets
- Shoes, slippers, and socks in good condition
- School bags and backpacks
- New hygiene essentials such as toothbrushes, soaps, sanitary napkins, water bottles, and lunch boxes

Educational Materials

- New notebooks or notebooks with sufficient unused pages
- Writing pads, folders, pencils, pens, erasers, sharpeners, and rulers
- Crayons, colour pencils, sketch pens, paints, and craft materials
- Storybooks, children's literature, dictionaries, reference books, and educational books
- Flashcards, puzzles, building blocks, board games, and other learning aids

Toys and Recreational Materials

- Safe, clean, and fully functional toys
- Dolls, toy cars, kitchen sets, and pretend-play toys
- Soft toys in clean and hygienic condition
- Educational toys and activity kits
- Sports equipment such as balls, bats, badminton rackets, skipping ropes, and indoor games

Hygiene & Dignity Essentials

Good hygiene is essential for a child's health, confidence, and dignity. Yet many children and families cannot afford even basic personal-care items.

You can support them by donating new and unused essentials such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, bathing and washing soaps, sanitary napkins, towels, combs, water bottles, lunch boxes, and other hygiene products that help children stay healthy, attend school confidently, and live with dignity.

Building & Infrastructure Support

A safe, clean, and welcoming environment can significantly improve a child's learning experience. Many schools, learning centres, shelters, and community spaces require basic repairs and infrastructure support to remain safe and functional.

Individuals, businesses, builders, suppliers, and corporate organisations can contribute construction materials such as cement, bricks, sand, tin or roofing sheets, tiles, paint, doors, windows, furniture, sanitary fittings, electrical fittings, lights, fans, and other essential materials.

Such contributions can help us repair classrooms, improve sanitation facilities, create safer learning spaces, and provide children with an environment where they can learn, grow, and dream with confidence.

Please note: For infrastructure-related donations, we encourage prior coordination so that materials can be accepted according to the specific requirements of the project.

THE ANNAPURNA PROGRAMME

Donate raw food materials and help ensure that hunger never takes away a child's chance to learn.

Hunger is one of the greatest barriers to a child's education and development. Many children come to school without having eaten a proper meal. Some are unable to concentrate in the classroom, while others miss school because their families struggle to arrange food every day.

Through our **Annapurna Programme**, Pehal Sanstha provides nutritious meals and food support to children and families in need. Your contribution of raw food materials can help us continue serving meals regularly and ensure that hunger does not take away a child's opportunity to learn, grow, and dream.

You can support the Annapurna Programme by donating

- Wheat flour
- Rice
- Pulses and lentils
- Cooking oil
- Sugar and salt
- Spices
- Suji, poha, and dalia
- Besan and other grains
- Dry fruits and nutritious snacks
- Packaged food materials with a sufficient shelf life
- Fresh fruits and vegetables, subject to prior coordination

Even a small quantity of food material can contribute towards preparing a wholesome meal. A bag of flour, a packet of pulses, or a container of cooking oil can help provide nourishment to several children.

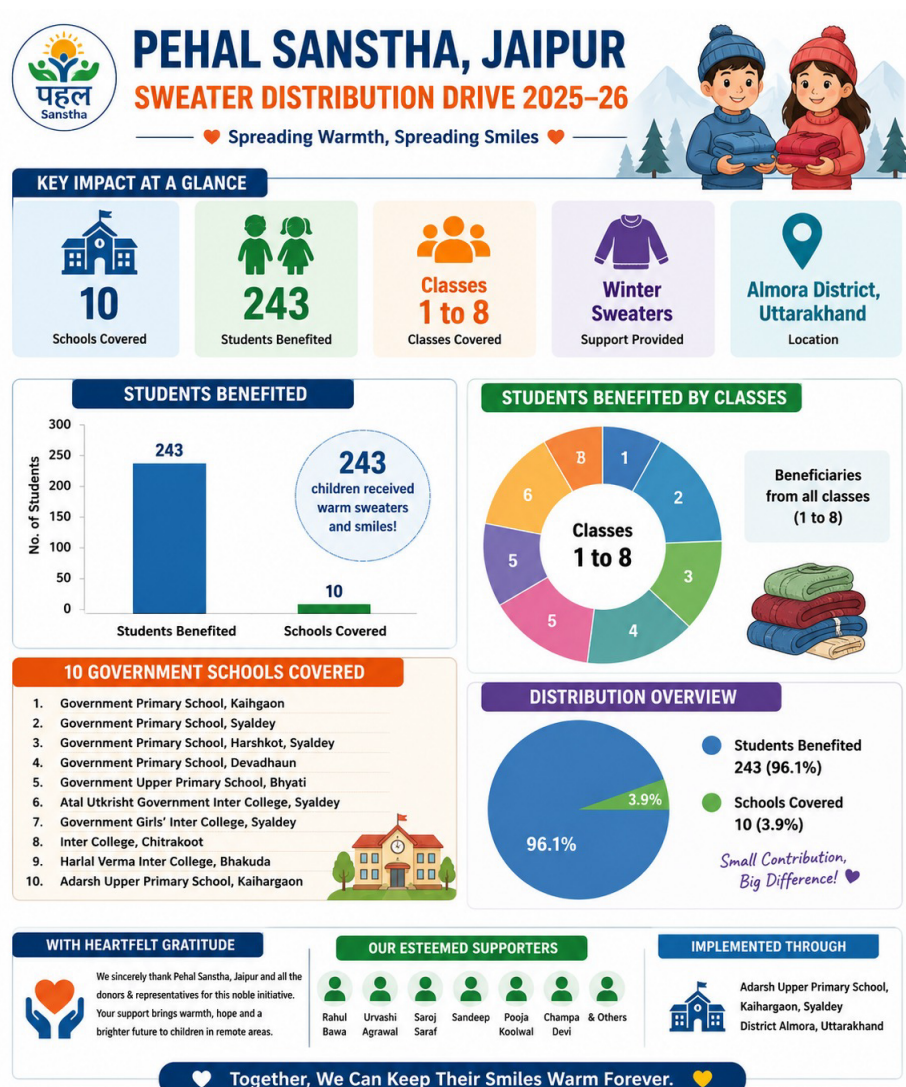
Do not let good clothes, books, toys, school supplies, or usable essentials remain forgotten in cupboards and storerooms. Donate them today.
