Reaching Children Where Support Is Needed Most

Pehal Sanstha's collaboration with government schools has now expanded beyond city boundaries to some of Rajasthan's most remote and underserved regions, including Jaisalmer, Barmer, Chittorgarh, and the tribal areas of Salumbar.

In these regions, many children attend school with determination and dreams for a better future, yet they often lack even the basic educational resources required for regular learning and practice. For them, a notebook, workbook, pencil, colour set, or learning activity is not merely a school supply — it is an opportunity to participate, learn with confidence, and feel that their dreams matter.

Through this collaboration, Pehal Sanstha is providing academic session kits to children studying in government schools. These kits contain essential learning and stationery materials that support children throughout the academic session, encourage regular classroom participation, and help reduce the burden on families facing financial hardship.

Reaching children in distant desert villages, tribal communities, and resource-constrained schools is one of our most meaningful commitments. Every academic kit placed in a child's hands carries a simple but powerful message:

“You are not alone. Your education matters, and your dreams deserve every opportunity to grow.”

Our aim is not only to provide educational materials, but also to bring dignity, encouragement, and hope into the lives of children who are eager to learn despite difficult circumstances.

With every new school and district we reach, our collaboration becomes stronger and our responsibility grows deeper. Their parents often struggle to meet even the basic needs of the household, and purchasing warm clothes for the harsh winter becomes difficult. Yet, despite the cold weather and financial hardships, these children continue to attend school with hope, determination, and a desire to learn.

Recognising their need, Pehal Sanstha distributed warm sweaters to children across 10 government primary schools in the Syaldey region. For these children, a sweater was not merely a piece of clothing — it was warmth, care, dignity, and a reminder that they were not alone.

Every sweater wrapped around a child carried a heartfelt message:

“Your circumstances may be difficult, but your dreams deserve warmth, support, and every opportunity to grow.”

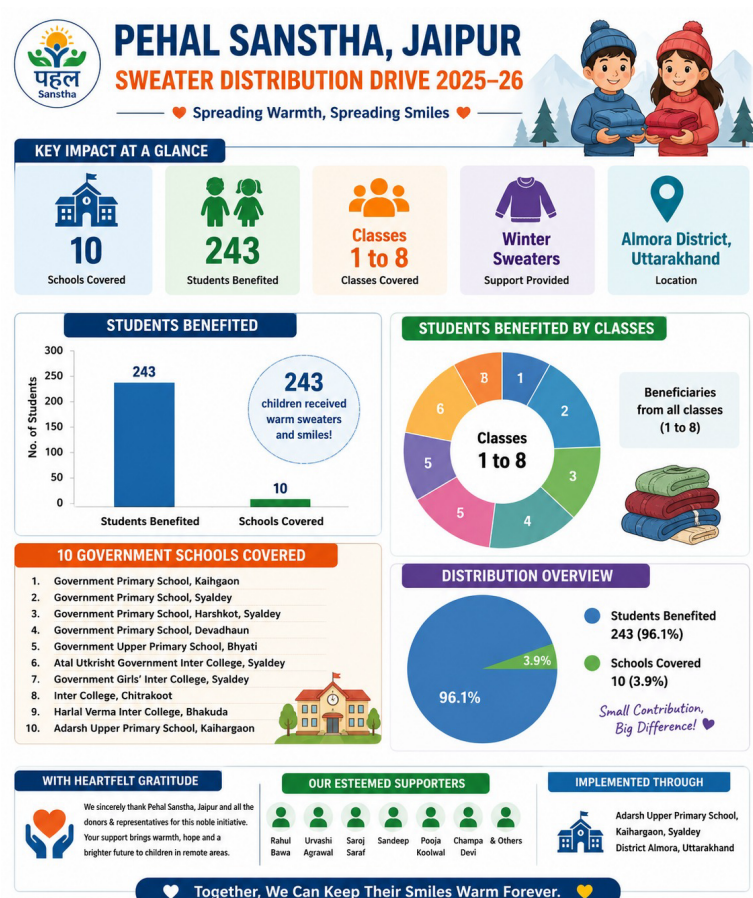
