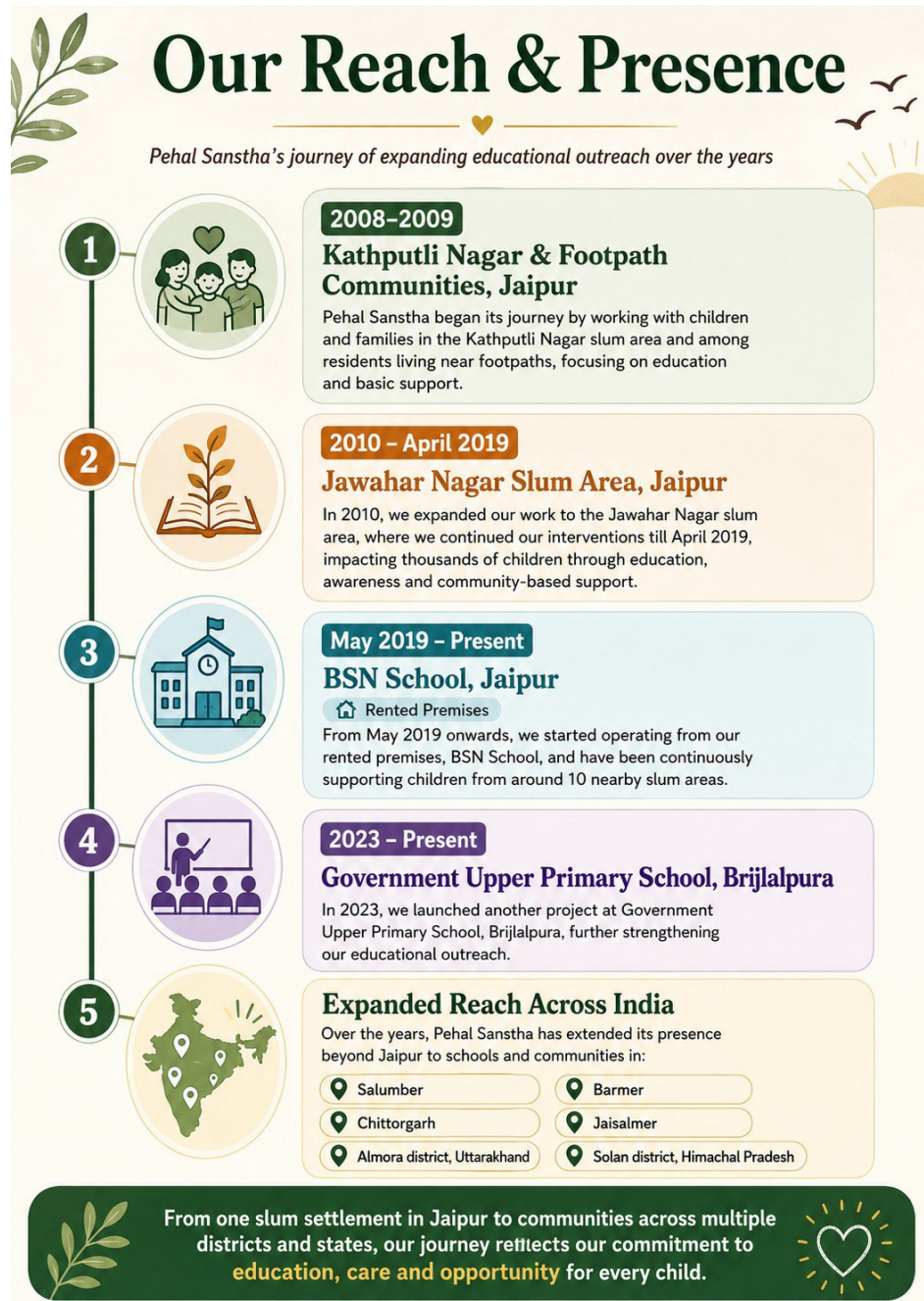


Our Reach & Presence

Pehal Sanstha's journey of expanding educational outreach over the years

Pehal Sanstha began its journey in 2008 with a commitment to reaching children and families living in underserved communities. Over the years, our presence has steadily expanded from slum settlements in Jaipur to government schools and communities across several districts and states.



A Timeline of Growth

2008 – 2009

Beginning at the Grassroots

Pehal Sanstha started its work in the Kathputli Nagar slum area of Jaipur. During this period, we also reached children and families living near footpaths and in other highly vulnerable conditions. Our initial efforts focused on education, basic support and creating a safe and encouraging environment for children.

2010 – APRIL 2019

Expanding to Jawahar Nagar

In 2010, we extended our work to the Jawahar Nagar slum area, where we continued our activities for nearly nine years. During this period, Pehal Sanstha supported thousands of children through educational assistance, learning activities, awareness programmes and community-based initiatives.

MAY 2019 – PRESENT

BSN School and Nearby Communities

Since May 2019, Pehal Sanstha has been operating from its rented premises, BSN School. From this centre, we currently reach children belonging to nearly 10 nearby slum areas.

The centre provides children with access to education, learning support, developmental activities and a safe space where they can learn, grow and build confidence.

2023 – PRESENT

Government School Intervention

In 2023, Pehal Sanstha started another project at Government Upper Primary School, Brijlalpura. Through this initiative, we support students with educational resources, activity-based learning and programmes aimed at strengthening their academic and personal development.

Expanding Beyond Jaipur

Over the years, Pehal Sanstha has expanded its reach to government schools and communities in different parts of India. Our initiatives have reached schools in:

- Chittorgarh
- Jaisalmer
- Almora district, Uttarakhand
- Solan district, Himachal Pradesh
